## Instructions for Diabetics and their Medications

For patients taking oral medications (pills or tablets by mouth) to control blood glucose:

- The **NIGHT** before your procedure, take your usual dose
- The **MORNING** of your procedure, **hold** your usual dose

## For patients taking injectable medications (Insulin) to control blood glucose:

- The **NIGHT** before your procedure, take your usual dose at the usual time
- The **MORNING** of the procedure:
  - Regular Insulin-DO NOT take the MORNING of your procedure
  - NPH, Lantus,70/30-Take half your usual dose the MORNING of your procedure

It is important to check your blood glucose level at home, at least 5 hours prior to your scheduled endoscopy. If your glucose is less than 60, drink 8oz of apple juice. When you arrive for your procedure, let the nurses know what your blood glucose level was at home.

Per your endoscopy prep instructions: You must be NPO (nothing by mouth) 4 hours prior to your endoscopy procedure – this includes water.
